

# Membership Upgrade Opportunities for Student Members of IAgRE

IAgRE is the professional society for engineers, managers, scientists, technologists and students working in the land based sector.

IAgRE welcomes you as a Student Member. Student members have all the benefits of full membership of IAgRE but without the use of designatory letters after their name.

There are however a number of upgrade options that may be available to you depending on your qualifications and experience.

- If you are an **undergraduate**, you are immediately eligible for membership at the **Associate** (student) grade at a fee of £20 per annum. Payment of this fee would allow you the use of the designatory letters **AIAgRE** after your name.
- If you are on a **postgraduate** course, then you are already deemed to be *qualified* in membership terms and are eligible for membership at the **Associate Member** grade. Fees for this grade (2012) are £45.

Payment of the appropriate fee would allow you the use of the designatory letters **AMIAgRE**.

- If you are on a **postgraduate** course and already have 4 + years of appropriate experience in our industry, then you may well be eligible for full membership (**Member** grade) and use of the letters **MIAgRE**. The fee (2012) for this is £115.00 per annum.

Those of you with accredited qualifications recognised by the Engineering Council (EngC) should ensure you are on the appropriate register.
