- The Landbased Technician Accreditation Scheme (LTA)

The Engineering Council

As a founding licensed body of the Engineering Council, IAgrE offers professional qualifications to suitably qualified and/or experienced engineers in three categories offered by the EngC:

- Chartered Engineer (CEng)
- Incorporated Engineer (IEng)
- Engineering Technician (EngTech)

The Society for the Environment (SocEnv)

As a founder constituent body of SocEnv, IAgrE awards the professional qualification of Chartered Environmentalist (CEnv) to those suitably qualified and/or experienced.

The Landbased Technician Accreditation Scheme (LTA)

IAgrE administers the LTA scheme on behalf of the landbased engineering sector. The LTA scheme offers a clear 4 tiered career path for those working as technicians in tractor and machinery dealerships.
